“We would like to provide training to each of our chapter members to make him or her a vocal advocate for HPV immunization.”

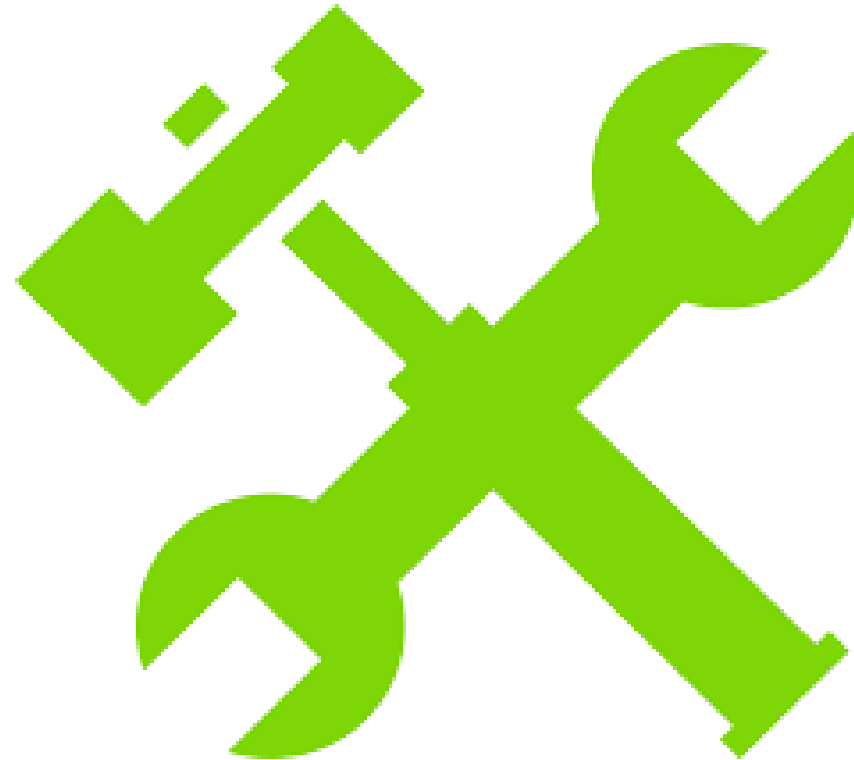

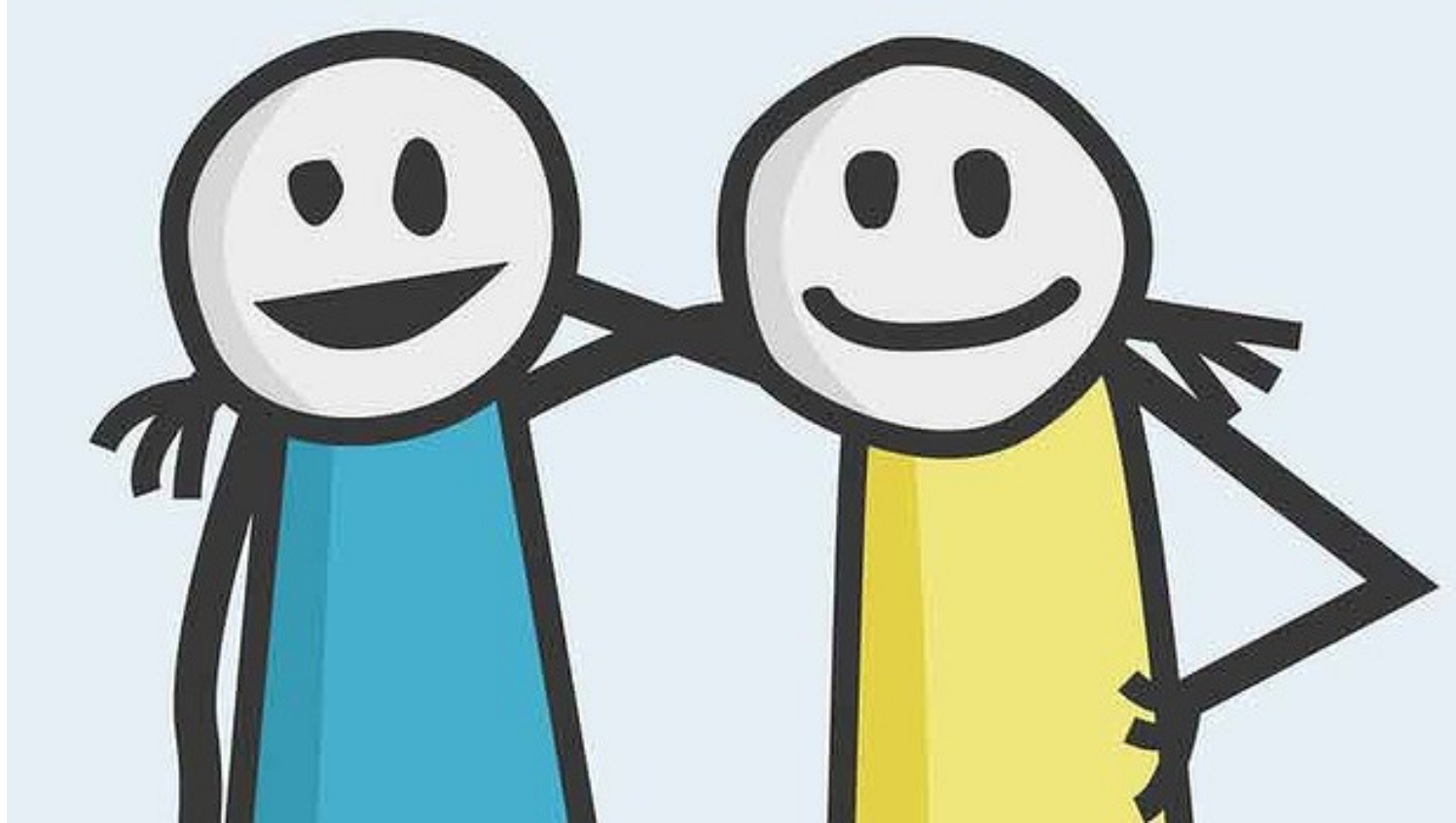
